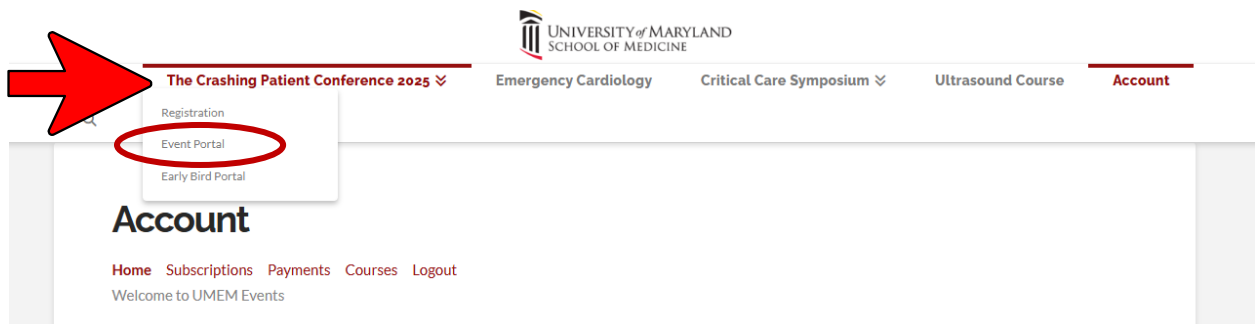

Frequently Asked Questions

What has changed about how I access the conference?

This year, The Crashing Patient Conference has transitioned from a multi-day live virtual event to a fully self-paced learning experience. Instead of logging in on one specific date to watch lectures live, participants now have on-demand access to every session.

Do I still need to attend at a scheduled time?

No. All conference lectures have been pre-recorded and uploaded to the learning platform. You can watch any session, at any time, from anywhere - whenever it best fits your schedule.

How long do I have access to the content?

Participants receive full access to all lectures and materials for three years. This gives you plenty of time to explore new topics, revisit sessions, or catch up on any lectures you didn't complete right away.

Why did the conference move to a self-paced format?

We know how unpredictable emergency medicine schedules can be. The self-paced format is designed to give you maximum flexibility, allowing you to learn, review, and engage with the content at your convenience—without the pressure of attending on a single day.

Is the educational content the same as previous years?

Yes! Every lecture is still delivered by our expert faculty and covers the high-risk, high-impact topics The Crashing Patient Conference is known for. The difference is simply how you access it: now entirely on your own schedule.

Will I still be able to earn CME credit?

Yes. CME information and instructions will be provided within the platform. You'll complete the required evaluations after watching the sessions, just as you would in a live format.

How do I claim continuing education credits/receive my certificate of participation?

To submit for CEU/CME or a certificate of participation you must view the lectures, and complete the post-lecture quiz and survey.

Once you have viewed all the lectures, you will need to complete the final CME Survey. This will trigger the certificate process. Surveys must be completed no later than December 1, 2028 to qualify for continuing education credits.

How will I know if I completed all my lecture quizzes and surveys?

When you are done with your lecture, you should click on the button that asks you to complete the lecture quiz/survey. If you have completed the lecture quiz/survey, you will not be able to access it again.

Once you have completed the final CME Survey, certificates will be emailed out on a rolling basis. Certificates will start being emailed out on January 12, 2026. After January 1, 2026 please allow for 10-15 business days once you have submitted your survey for your certificate to be emailed to you.
